HEAVY EQUIPMENT ON DIECKGRAEFF ROAD

June 27 & 28, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Please be advised of the following concern from the Seward Bear Creek Flood Service Area Board (SBCFSAB):

The Japp Creek culverts on Dieckgraeff Road to the KPB Transfer Station are nearing capacity. The short term mitigation project to clean out the 12ft and 2- 4ft culverts for the main channel was completed by Great Northern Construction April 17, 2019. With the recent hot temperatures and rapid snow melt, sediment is filling the catch basin around the culverts created last November and April. The forecast has several days of 70+ temperatures and it is expected that local streams will continue with high velocities and sediment transport. There is still some freeboard and the drainage ditching improved last fall should capture much of the flows, but it is possible Dieckgraeff could be overtopped.
