City of Seward Sidewalk Project - D

The City of Seward desires to receive bids from qualified contractors to install a new exterior concrete sidewalk with curb and gutter on Adams Ave at 5th St. (at the City of Seward Annex building), and replace the existing sidewalk with curb and gutter on 4th Ave (near the Alehouse Bar).

The scope of work generally includes providing approximately 250 feet of new exterior concrete sidewalks with curb and gutter. An additional 52ft of curb and gutter will also be removed and replaced.

The bid documents will be available on July 22, 2020 Electronically only. The Electronic copies are available for no charge.
